1.If anything was possible, what would your dream job be, and why?

To be a public teacher has been my childhood dream. I am fond of this profession because of 3 things, namely, benefits, cause and impact, and lifelong stability. The first thing on the list is the benefits. It is an undeniable fact that I need financial assistance in my everyday endeavors.
