1.If anything was possible, what would your dream job be, and why?

I grew up having no dream job, it's not that I don't have dreams in life but I haven't figured out yet what I wanted to be. When the pandemic happened one of the industries that were greatly affected by it was the tourism industry but after the easing of restrictions to travel the tourism industry started to recover because of what the Department of Tourism Secretary promoted which is domestic travel and that's when I started to aspire to be like her because she was so wise and she's really good at her job. It came to my mind that I wanted also to be a Tourism officer here in the Philippines because I wanted to help our economy through this industry. Moreso, being a tourism officer can give me the privilege to work and travel at the same time. And if that happens, I can start working with tourism here in Bacolod City because I know that this city has a lot of potential and can attract investors for the improvement of this city.

2. Have you ever experienced a stressful situation in your past workplace (college if fresh graduate), what was it and how did you overcome it?

Yes, I experienced a stressful situation when I was still in college. It was pre-pandemic and I was the class president and at the same time a college organization representative, so what happened is that our org had an event for our tourism week, my job was just to help and run the event smoothly but unfortunately, things happened like one of my classmates backed out before the event because there was no make-up artist and the organization didn't have any photographer so I was stressed because of it and the other team members didn't know what to. But to save the day what I did I calmed myself first before I took an action. Since I also have a responsibility as a class president, I asked a favor to one of my classmates to fill in and I did her make-up and so the problem was solved. And as a college org representative, I also have a responsibility to make the event successful so I borrowed a DSLR camera from our school's creatives and became the photographer of the event. This is what I normally do in this kind of stressful situations, I have to calm myself first to organize my thoughts and next is to make an action in every problem I encounter.

3. In your previous position, what task did you find most challenging and why? What task did you enjoy most and why?

When I was in college, I was a working student and was assigned to our college department, the task that was very challenging to me was to enroll and encode the student's subject to our school's system at first it was really confusing because some codes are similar and just 1 error character it could affect to the student's account. But as I was doing it every day, I got used to it though there were still minimal mistakes it was manageable, and our dean relied on me for that. On the other hand, the task that I really enjoyed is when I became a student lecturer during our SHS immersion program because during that week-long event I made presentations and lectured students on how to make a tour package, design a brochure and flyers, I was able to enhance my communication skills through that event, and that task pushed me to become better and nurtured my leadership skills.

4. How would your previous managers/coworkers describe you?

My classmates would describe me as a leader and an approachable classmate. It is because my whole college life I am always a class president and a leader in every group work, at first, I doubted my capabilities but I was convinced that I was a good leader through their feedback they told me I was very considerate and I'm not a leader who just boss around and that gave me the confidence to lead that's why I joined our college organization. Also, whenever there are things that my classmates wouldn't understand like our lessons or instructions in every activity, they will come to me and I would help them. Moreso, even my college professors would describe me as a reliable and trustworthy student because they gave me tasks that is outside our subjects like doing documents for the accreditation of our college department, and like our dean and administrative assistant, they trusted me that I could do the tasks they gave me because there was a time, that our AA was absent and our dean had meetings but still they feel at ease because they me in our department.

5. What personal or professional accomplishments are you most proud of?

My personal accomplishment that I am most proud of is when I graduated as the first ever Magna Cum Laude in our college department, when our dean told me about that I felt so honored and at the same time I was proud of myself because college was really draining especially when pandemic happened but because of my determination to finish my studies I survived and I didn't even expect to have that award because the standards of our school were very high compared to the grading system of the other schools. While the professional accomplishment that I am proud of is when I was invited by Pathcutters to have a trial period and I am now in my 5th day because based on what I heard and read on social media that recruitment is really hard and especially the trial period so given this opportunity is already an accomplishment for me even though I'm not hired yet.
