1.If anything was possible, what would your dream job be, and why?

If anything was possible, my dream job would be a full-time content creator. 2. Have you ever experienced a stressful situation in your past workplace (college if fresh graduate), what was it and how did you overcome it?

I have experienced a lot of stressful situations during my college days, but what really had a big impact on me was when we were making our Feasibility Study. It was very stressful since that time classes were done online. It was difficult to reach your groupmates to do our Feasibility, as most of them went back to their respective provinces, our teachers also are not available at any time and the resources and time spent doing class discussions through online set-up are not enough, and the biggest problem is having a stable connection. It was difficult delegating the tasks to my groupmates, since others may have not seen it because there is no stable connection, and I was left doing their part for us to pass on time. I was very stressed since my workload doubled. What I did to overcome it is that I communicated with them earlier, assigning them their part and setting a due date for them to pass on time.

3. In your previous position, what task did you find most challenging and why? What task did you enjoy most and why?

During my internship days at Commission on Audit – PNP Team, I was given tasks of doing summary reports of collections and deposits of different departments, like DILG, Regional Trial Court, Bureau of Fire Protection, and Land Registration Authority. One of my schoolmates told me that she thought I was hard to approach and that I would be hard to be a friend, and that I should have gone and approached their table where they are seated earlier since it was nearing the end of our internship. She would not have thought that I was also funny, talkative, and not shy. Some of them said that I am clean with my things, organized, and I have nice penmanship. They would sometimes go to me and ask if I could write on their DTR so that it would look neat. Our supervisor also at Commission on Audit has seen me going back and forth doing some photocopies of the errors, and he commented that how good of me to spot erroneous errors, even just a decimal place or lack of a centavo from the report.

5. What personal or professional accomplishments are you most proud of?

What I am personally most proud of is that I graduated on time, and surprisingly with a Latin honor. I would not have thought that I could survive college and finish on time. I was close to giving up and having a break from school when I was in my third year of college, because of the stress and self-doubt I went through. But grace upon grace, I survived, and having a Latin honor is just a bonus for me. Another one is that I passed the Civil Service Exam last August 2022. I did not expect to really pass since I have not reviewed that much, and only reviewed some of the topics 3 days prior to the exam. I was telling myself to just take it again and better luck next time. I just used all my stored knowledge and have been familiar with some of the topics since it was like a high school test, it was just I was challenged in Math since I am not really a fan of it. When the result came out, I was just hoping that my name is posted, and if not, I can just take it again next time, but luckily, my name was on the list of passers.
